Forum THNS2023, entitled " Resilient Transport for Livable City ", is to be held online & on-site, between 13th to 16th of November, 2023.

About THNS

The Forum T-H-N-S got her name from the theme of the first edition in 2008- "Transport à Haut Niveau Service" (transport of high-level service). THNS is an International Symposium on the Sustainable Development of Urban Transport Systems, jointly initiated in 2008 by Tongji University, ParisTech and the French Ministry for the Environment. During the past years, it has been supported by the Chinese Ministry of Housing, Urban Planning and Rural Construction, the Chinese Ministry of Transportation, the French Ministry for the Ecological and Solidary Transitions and many other Chinese, French and international institutions in the relevant fields.

The Forum especially fosters the East-West exchange of knowledge advances: research outcomes, innovative technologies, implementation reports etc. It brings together academics, policy makers and business representatives with expertise in urban planning and urban management, transport, public transport, rail transport, energy and the environment.

Dual mode of THNS2023 (online & on-site)

From 2020, affected by the Covid-19 pandemics, three editions have been held online and have attracted more than 600 participants from 20 countries. In 2023, with the world gradually coming back to normal, THNS2023 is tentatively adapting a dual mode, i.e. online presentations from all over the world combined with on-site presentations taking place simultaneously in Shanghai and Paris.

Schedule and working language

The Forum will be held during the week from **13th to 16th November, 2023**.the sessions will be tentatively arranged in **3 afternoons and 1 morning (Beijing Time)**, that is, **3 mornings and 1 night session (Paris Time)**, by a dual mode, i.e., online presentations from all over the world combined with on-site presentations taking place simultaneously in Shanghai and Paris.

The working language is English. A small part of presentations will be given in Chinese with English simultaneous interpretation.

Submission and Registration

Prospective speakers please submit your research by **31th July, 2023**. The submission must include an abstract (around 300-500 words suggested, including title) and personal biography. **We will notify speakers of acceptance before 15th September, 2023**. Accepted speakers should prepare a 15-minute presentation (in English preferred).

All participants including accepted speakers and general audience shall register online by 5th November. The registration is free of charge.

“THNS Research Awards”

Outstanding talks of the year will be rewarded “**Best Research Awards**” (Gold/Silver/Bronze awards) or “**Best Student Research Awards**”, which are provided to encourage relevant original researches and significant contributions to knowledge development. The selection will be conducted by the scientific committee of THNS2023, and the results will be published within one month after the event.
